Authorization to Sign HEAT TREATMENT CERTIFICATION USING A KILN FACILITY

I, as an agent of the Pacific Lumber Inspection Bureau authorized to sign official PLIB *Heat Treatment Certification Using a Kiln Facility* certificates, agree to sign only certificates fully made out and then only on lumber that has been heat treated to the extent that all parts of the wood, including the core, have reached a temperature of at least 133 degrees Fahrenheit (56 degrees Centigrade) for 30 minutes, and in the case of heat treated lumber that is certified to be kiln dried, that the moisture content of the wood has been reduced to less than 20 percent by weight. It is also agreed that such lumber conforms to the Memorandum of Understanding between the USDA Animal Plant Health Inspection Service and the Pacific Lumber Inspection Bureau.

I further agree that if my company participates in the PLIB Electronic HT Certificate Program, I will review the contents of all electronic HT certificates and associated kiln records prior to granting permission to anyone in my company to use my electronic signature on an electronic HT certificate.
